CALEO ORIGINAL ...

designed by Rikke Frost, was the first in the series and runner up on the popular Danish TV competition show, 'Denmark's Next Classic'.

The name comes from Latin and means "to highlight", which refers to the lamps detailed look and emphasis on craftsmanship

CALEO combines a brass angular bar which completes the pleated shade, so that the pleating effect can be rotated to a 90 degree angle.





THE CALEO SERIES

Taking inspiration from CALEO ORIGINAL, a whole new series was created to include small and medium-sized cone-shaped pendants.


We have re-interpreted Esben Klint's beautiful pendant, model 107, into a brand new table lamp design. Light oak and brass details, together with a choice of lampshades, in LE KLINT original materials, gives us a series of table lamps in sizes medium, small and x-small.



The Mushroom

This classic yet popular design, returns. The handpleated shade still stands proudly, atop its untreated light oak wooden wall mount.





Vilhelm Wohlert (1920-2007), an architect and a professor, was trained at the Academy of Fine Arts in Copenhagen, where he was a student of Kaare Klint.

His most significant works include the renovation of the Ny Carlsberg Glyptotek, Louisiana, the Bochum museum, the Gustav Lübcke museum as well as a string of other constructions and restorations.

The Mushroom, was originally created in 1957 as a commissioned piece by Vilhelm Wohlert, for the reception area, of the honorary residence of professor and Nobel Prize winner Niels Bohr, on his return home to Denmark.

Design duo Jonah Takagi (American) and Hallgeir Homstvedt (Norwegian). LAMELLA pendant's, now includes a small version, LAMELLA 4.

This small design was inspired by the delicate pleats on the underside of mushroom caps. LAMELLA is elegantly finished in a choice of brass or aluminium details.



CARRONADE High Table

Our new CARRONADE High Table in Black and Nordic colours, has been fashioned into a miniature version of the CARRONADE High floor lamp, which includes the distinctive slender tripod legs and tilting head.

CARRONADE High Table has the exact features as the series, where walnut or oak wood and brass or aluminium details supports a metal head that has a diffuser for optional use.

Unique and fascinating - model 101 is the perfect combination of design and craftsmanship. The enclosed shape makes The Lantern perfect for hanging high because it shades the light source at all angles.

As a salute to one of his design idols, Kaare Klint, who designed the original lantern, CEO Kim Weckstrøm Jensen, re-designed this lamp into an XL-version, with a brush steel fitting, in 2007.

Today, the LE KLINT team has further expanded the collection, to include two more amazing sizes, XX-large and X-small.


